


John Davis Political Report Accurately Projected 100% of NC Senate Races November 2, 2010

- #1: As projected, the NC Senate will have a Republican majority for the first time since 1898.
- #2: As projected, Democrats won all of the races in which they were "Likely Winners" and "Favored."
- #3: As projected, Republicans won all of the races in which they were "Likely Winners" and "Favored."
- #4: Republicans won two of the three "Toss up" races, including former Sen. Tony Rand's seat in Cumberland County (now held by appointee Margaret Dickson), and former Sen. Charlie Albertson's seat in Duplin, Lenoir and Sampson Counties.
- #5: As projected, seats held by these Democrats were won by Republians: Margaret Dickson, Cumberland; Charlie Albertson, Du plin; R.C. Soles, Columbus; Julia Boseman, New Hanover; Don Davis, Green; Tony Foriest, Alamance; Steve Goss, Watauga; Joe Sam Queen, Haywood; John Snow, Cherokee; David Hoyle, Gaston; A.B. Swindell, Nash
